Introduction

This live webinar session has been designed to introduce doctors to the key principles of medical law and ethics as both are so intertwined, and as a doctor, understanding the key aspects of medical law and its implications for their clinical practice is essential to the safe care of patients.

This programme will provide participants with a good overview of key legal issues in everyday practice and help them to understand some of the principles that the courts apply to medical negligence cases.

It will also help delegates to consider the ethical aspects/consequences of their decision making and think about the decisions they are making not just in a medical/clinical sense but how their actions might affect their patients (and their families) holistically.
